2023-2024 Employee Scholarship Criteria

To help off-set the cost of training your employees, the BLD Connection Nebraska Board of Directors and Scholarship Committee are making available \$100 scholarships for Nebraska members attending LumberTech courses. LumberTech courses currently include Estimating 1-2-3, Blueprint Reading & Material Take-off; Yard & Delivery Managers Workshop, Yard & Delivery Operations Workshop, Sales Development, LBM Inventory Management, Risk Management for LBM Dealers, Improving Profits and Gross Margin Mastery.

To be considered for a scholarship:

- 1) The company must be a current NLA retail yard member.
- 2) Applicants must register and pay for a LumberTech class.
- 3) A completed scholarship application must be submitted to the NLA office before September 30, 2024.

There is a limited number of scholarships available. Applications will be considered on a first come/first served basis. A limit of three scholarships will be awarded per company (this includes headquarters & line yards) during the 2023-2024 class season.

Payment for scholarships will be mailed to the employee company after class has been completed. Scholarships will not be paid directly to the employee.
